



My name is the Green Defender. Let me help you find ways to save energy in your house!






Unplug and Save:


Not everything needs to be plugged in all the time. Ask Mom and Dad which energy hogs in your house can be unplugged.












Turn off and Save

If you can't unplug it, turn it off when you are done. Ask mom and dad when you can turn off energy hogs around your home.











Close the Blinds

Remind your parents to close the blinds when you leave the house to help keep your house cool in the summer and warm in the winter.









Check the Thermostat

Heating your house uses a TON of energy! Help mom and dad keep the heat in check by making sure it doesn't go lower than 70°.









Last out? LIGHTS OUT!

When you leave a room, always turn out the lights. It's the easiest way to save energy!








Sun Out? LIGHTS OUT!
