

My name is Eco the Energy Dog. I'm here to help you find ways to save energy in your homes!






Unplug and Save

Unplugging things around the house when they aren't being used is an awesome way to help mom and dad save energy Ask your parents when you can help unplug energy hogs around your house.








Turn Off and Save

If you can't unplug something, make sure you turn it off when you are done using it. That way, it won't be using as much energy. Ask your parents when you can turn off energy hogs around your home.










Close the Blinds




Check the Thermostat

Heating your house makes up almost 25% of the total energy your house uses! Help Mom and Dad keep the thermostat in check by making sure it doesn't go lower than 70°.








Last Out? LIGHTS OUT!
